

NEBDN Schedule Fees and Charges for Diploma 2025/26

- ❖ This schedule should be read in conjunction with [NEBDN's Fees and Invoicing Policy](#)
- ❖ Provider accreditation fee is £500.
- ❖ Accredited Providers should also refer to the Provider Resources on The Hub.
- ❖ Fees listed under all 'Admissions' sections are directly chargeable/invoiced to accredited Providers (not Learners).
- ❖ Queries relating to invoices should be raised within 48 hours of receipt of invoice to accounts@nebdn.org. Following the 48-hour grace period all fees will be payable.
- ❖ **All fees must be paid before the exam date.**
- ❖ Except where stated, fees are not refundable and cannot be transferred between Learners.
- ❖ Providers will have a 48-hour grace period to make any adjustments around registration, deferrals or withdrawals.
- ❖ We will accept direct payment from Learners for products and services listed under the 'Learner fee schedule' only.

Transfer of Learner to an alternative NEBDN accredited Provider (payable by new Provider) Registration of Learner to an alternative NEBDN accredited Provider must be made within 20 working days of the withdrawal from the previous Provider. After this point, all account information will be deleted, and no PoE can be transferred across. New registration (subject to the full registration fee) will then be applicable for any Learner wishing to continue their studies. Transfer is of Learner only. Any change of exam dates or resits will incur an additional fee.	£150

⁵ Learners can take a maximum of three Professional Discussion resits after which they must begin the course again.

New registration (subject to the full registration fee) will then be applicable for any Learner wishing to continue their studies. Any exam date changes or resits for transferred Learners will incur a deferral fee.	£150
